- One Angling Log per angler is required.
- Measure and photograph your fish with fish's mouth touching the end of the measuring stick, tail pinched and length clearly identifiable.
- Photograph yourself with the fish for the photo slide show presentation.
- Lengths should be recorded to the nearest 1/4"
- Largest Fish includes the following species: Sunfish, Crappie, Northern Pike/Musky, Walleye, Largemouth/Smallmouth Bass, and Rough fish
- Highest Average Categories include a limit of fish for the following species: (3) Northern Pike, (6) Walleye, (6) Bass (large/small combination).
- Largest fish winners are not allowed to "double dip" and use a "largest fish" winner to compete for the Highest Average award.
- We encourage catch-photo-release fishing so you can record all fish caught for the day and potentially submit a limit of fish for the highest average award and still be able to submit a fish for the largest fish award without "double dipping." (ex. If the angler catches and records four Northern Pike, three can be used for the highest average award and one can be used for the largest fish award. MN state fishing regulations prohibit you from keeping all four Northern Pike).
- Use the optional category for a species that you wish to compete for both the largest fish and highest average awards.
- Culling is not allowed.
- For this fish-a-thon if you release your fish after photographing and recording them, state and body of water slot limits do not apply. [You could record more than one 20"+ walleye.]
- This form will be collected at the digital weigh in at the award ceremony on September 10, 2011 at the Blue Line Sports Bar and Grill, Sartell. **You must be in line by 6:00 p.m. You must be present to win.**

- All MN angling and boating regulations apply unless otherwise noted.
